Mode of study: Blended: online and face to face

Face to face: Thursday to Saturday once every six weeks

Structure of the course: Four boot camps of one week each. 8 long

weekends of 3 days each

Be a holder of a Bachelor's degree with Upper Second-Class honors or its equivalent from a recognized university; or Bachelor's degree with Lower Second-Class honors and with 2 years of experience; or Bachelor's degree and Postgraduate Diploma with a minimum achievement of Credit; and show evidence of competence to do rigorous research work.

Bachelor of Arts in Sustainable Human Development

A unique program designed to equip individuals with innovative problem solving skills. The BA in Sustainable Human Development empowers students to tackle various complex challenges and thus contribute to creating positive and sustainable impact in Africa. It trains agents of social transformation who accompany communities in their transformation, with a special focus on human and sustainable development, justice, peace and reconciliation, project management and linking faith to social responsibility. It equips the students with the most sought skills in the human development, church organisation and civil society.


